**FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE**

**Winter Sports Sign Up is beginning**

**NYS Requirements**

If your child has signed up for a winter sport, there must be a current physical exam (within the last 12 months) on file in the nurse's office, prior to the first practice. This physical must be complete by a NYS physician, physician's assistant or nurse practitioner.

A 30 Day Health Update Form is also required unless a physical exam was done within 30 days of the start of the sport season. This form is available on the website and must be given to the coach or nurse before they begin practice.

Any student who fails to provide necessary documentation and completion of all health requirements will not be granted clearance to play.

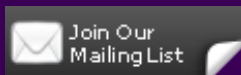
