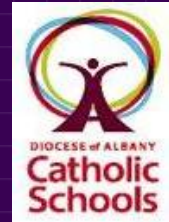

A Note from the Nurse

When your child is ill...

We need your help to reduce the spread of illness in our school. Please remember to follow these general rules:

Please keep your child home from school until he/she has gone a FULL 24 hours:

- without a temperature over 100 degrees
- without any vomiting
- without diarrhea
- after starting an antibiotic
- without red eyes with thick or crusty drainage

We rely heavily on parents' good judgment about sending their children to school. Please use your best judgment before sending your child to school with:

- A green runny nose: red and itchy/painful eyes
- A persistent cough

- A low grade fever (under 100 but above 99)
- Any persistent complaints that the child does not feel well
- A persistent sore throat
- An open sore that is red or draining

All transcript requests need to be made in Naviance to be sent out to the colleges. Requests should be at least 2 weeks in advance to ensure that the school materials are there by the deadline. Mrs. Barnes can not send out a transcript or information to a college if she does not know if students have applied.

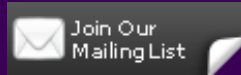
