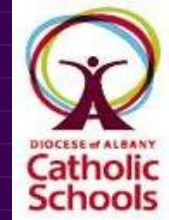

I would like to highly encourage you to read the book "American Girls" by Nancy Jo Sales for a summer read. I have read this book. It was extremely enlightening and horrifying at the same time. After reading this book I am convinced every parent, teacher, grandparent, anyone responsible for the development of our youth and young adults needs to read this book to become aware of what our young people are doing and experiencing on the web and how peer pressure affects what they do. This book takes us through the technology world of our girls and boys.

The New York Times review says this:

"In her discursive new book, "American Girls," the journalist Nancy Jo Sales examines the effects that growing up in the turbulent seas of social media are having on American girls. It looks not only at high-profile cases of predatory assault and cyberbullying, but also at how day-to-day life inside an online bubble can narrow one's view of the world and warp relationships and self-esteem."

Ms. Sales travels across the country interviewing girls about their every day life with the web and gives statistics right up to October 2015. This book is extremely relevant for all of us.

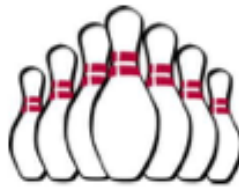

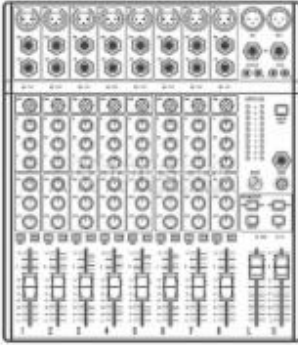

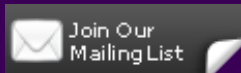
