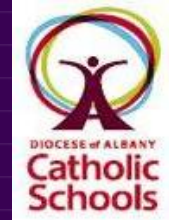

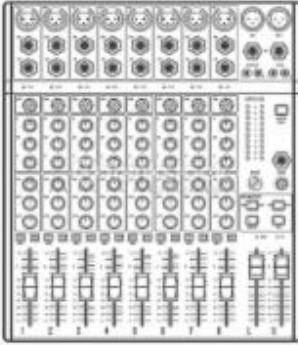
New York State Immunization Guidelines

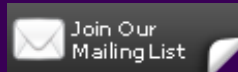
