# Meeting Minutes Wednesday, March 31, 2021

### **Opening**

### **Approval of Minutes**

A motion was made to accept the February 24, 2021 meeting minutes by Fran Dingeman and was seconded by Mary Fornabia. Minutes were unanimously approved.

#### **Introduction of Guests**

### State of the School Report: Joseph Kilmade, School Principal

- Clubs and sports continue to progress. Basketball concluded without incident. Good energy in the school with the additional activities. Prom will take place as well.
- Two open houses are scheduled for 4/15 and 4/17. These will take place by appointment. Teachers will be on hand at both. Positive response so far
- Current and new family registration continues. As of date of meeting, 125 reregistrations collected and 25 new families signed on. Projected enrollment to start 21-22 school year is around 200 students
- Staffing will remain consistent for 21-22 school year
- Covid protocols remain in place. Positive, but contained, case led the school to work fully remote for one day. School and students easily transitioned in and out of remote procedures.
- No mandates as of yet from the Diocese regarding Covid vaccine requirements
- Covid restrictions will dictate number of course offerings for 21-22 school year
- A social media blue print is being developed to help with overall marketing

### **Committee Reports**

Enrollment (Fran Dingeman and Mary Fornabia):

- West Mountain event was a success. Approximately 40 families in attendance.
- A State of The School address has not been scheduled as of yet
- Discussions continue on possible Bowling Family Event for late April or early May
- Welcome Committee continues to reach out to new families
- Climate surveys will be sent out by end of the school year
- Partner schools have been contacted but student event has not been formalized
- Next Enrollment Committee meeting TBD

### Advancement/Development (Dawn Martinez):

- Spring SCC Triple Crown 50/50 raffle ready to begin. Flyers are ready to be distributed. Tickets will be \$100 each. The drawing will take place live on YouTube on June 6<sup>th</sup>.
- David Fizer will be chairing golf tournament. Plans are in the works.
- Gala has been booked at the Holiday Inn for January 2022
- Event honoring former coach will be held at the school. Plans to incorporate this into an alumni event are being discussed.

### Facilities (Joe Kilmade):

- New locks installed on school building and annex. Cameras and key fob type openers incorporated into the design.
- Meetings continue on parish center and kitchen construction. Plans are moving forward as scheduled.
- Wireless infostructure needs to be addressed. School will be looking into multiple funding sources (grants) to complete necessary upgrades

### Mission Enhancement (Becky Stauffer):

- Rebecca Cronin and the junior class spearheaded a fundraiser to build a home in Haiti. Nearly all of the money was raised to successfully complete the project.
- Seniors will hold a reading of the Passion

#### Finance and Financial Aid (Michael Kondratowicz):

 Additional costs incurred due to Covid remain. Transportation for sports has been an added cost as well

- PPP loan forgiveness remains unclear. Diocese is reaching out to lending institution for further details
- School plans to apply for additional EANS funding
- Tuition arrears has not increased. Some delinquent payments have been made. Families have been contacted as well
- Financial aid for the 2021-2022 school year will be completed by April 16<sup>th</sup>.
  Applications will be reviewed and decisions will be made by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Aid award dollar amounts from Cabrini and Beacon of Hope will be known after April 15<sup>th</sup>
- Goal for 21-22 school year is to add more supportive classes if budget allows.

- Fr. James Ebert accepted invitation to join
- Jeffrey Pompa's application is awaiting Pastor referral

Event date is April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Open to all 9-12 grade students. Presentations will take place in 30-minute increments. Schedule will be set for students who wish to participate.
