Families are welcome to visit the store to try on uniforms for sizing before purchasing. An online ordering option is also available for added convenience.

Gym shorts are available for purchase; however, they may **only** be worn during gym class. Students who choose to wear gym shorts must change back into their uniform sweatpants after gym class for the remainder of the school day.

It is highly recommended that families label all uniform pieces with their student's name. This helps us return lost items to their owners and reduces the number of unclaimed uniforms.

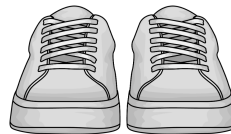

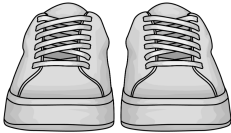

Electronic Devices

Personal electronic devices, including laptops, tablets, and other similar devices, are **not permitted** at school. If a computer is needed for classroom instruction, the school will provide a class set of devices for student use during the school day.

As a Google Classroom school, students may need access to a computer or tablet at home to complete classwork and assignments. Each student will be provided with a school-issued Google email address to access Google Classroom and other school-approved educational resources.

Students are encouraged to bring a book to school to read if they finish their classwork early or have free time during the school day.

Supply Lists

Students should come to school on the first day prepared with general school supplies, such as pens, pencils, notebooks, and paper. Teachers will review class expectations at the start of the school year and will provide any additional course-specific supply requirements or recommendations needed for students to be successful in their classes.

First Day of School & New Student Orientation

The first day of school is **Wednesday, September 9, 2026**.

New Student and Parent Orientation will be held on **Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.** The orientation will last approximately one hour.

During orientation, students will:

- Receive their class schedules and textbooks.
- Walk through their daily schedules.
- Set up their lockers.

Parents will meet with school administrators and key staff members for a brief welcome and overview of important information for the upcoming school year. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions while students become familiar with the building and their schedules.

Saratoga Central Catholic School operates on a **9-period A/B Day schedule**. The school day begins at **8:18 a.m.** with Homeroom and concludes at **2:20 p.m.**
