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APPLICATION CHECKLIST

STEP 1:

Complete the application forms and mail them to our Admissions Office. Include the \$100.00 application fee. Make check payable to Saratoga Central Catholic.

STEP 2:

Complete the transcript request form and forward it with the application.

STEP 3:

Personal interview: You may be called by our Guidance Office to be scheduled for an interview.

We highly encourage all students to take part in our "Saint for a Day" Program.

Steps 1-3 must be completed by early spring for our first review of acceptances. All additional applications will be reviewed upon completion of Steps 1-3. Acceptance letters will be mailed starting on February 1.

Thank you for your interest in Saratoga Central Catholic School.

This packet includes all the paperwork necessary for a prospective student to apply to our school for grades 6 - 12. Included is:

- a data sheet necessary for computer entry,
- a transcript request form, which allows us to review your child's academic background in order for us to render a decision, and
- a family survey form.

All three documents must be returned to us. Please also note that there is a non-refundable \$100.00 application fee, which must accompany the application.

An interview with the student and the parent(s) is usually required. At that time an overview of Saratoga Central Catholic's philosophy, program, and expectations are explained. A candid discussion of the applicant's academic and disciplinary history takes place as well.

The 2017-2018 tuition rate is \$6,180 for grades 6-8 and \$8,340 for grades 9-12. Additionally, there is a \$250 activity fee.

If your district provides busing to Saratoga Central Catholic, it is important that you pick up a transportation request form from your school district. Ordinarily these need to be filed by April 1.

Be advised that we offer a substantial amount of financial aid to students. Application must be made by April 15.

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HISTORY & HERITAGE

St. Peter's Academy | Saratoga Central Catholic

The History and heritage of St. Peter's Academy/Saratoga Central Catholic began in 1862 when the Sisters of Saint Joseph of Carondelet opened the first parochial school in Saratoga Springs. The school building, which also served as the home of the Sisters, was located on William Street. Young ladies were educated in this building and boys were taught in a separate building at the corner of Hamilton and William Streets.

The school grew slowly during the 1860's but began to dwindle in size during the 1870's. Shrinking enrollment caused the school to close in 1882 and the nuns returned to their Provincial house in August of that year.

Under the leadership of Father McDonnell, who became pastor in 1892, the school was revived. His successor, Father Flood, focused greater attention on the school and it began to achieve success. In 1900, the Sisters of Saint Joseph of Carondelet were called back to Saratoga to again staff the school. The first graduation exercises were conducted on June 27, 1905, when three students were awarded Regents diplomas.

In 1922, Father Patrick Scully, opened a newer and larger Catholic school. This building is now referred to as the Annex.

In 1944, the Very Reverend Daniel R. Bums he came the pastor of St. Peter's and immediately began to grow enrollment by inviting non-parishioners to attend the school. Enrollment more than doubled during the next few years. This increased enrollment created a need to expand facilities. In the spring of

1952, a capital campaign was conducted to raise funds for a new high school and gymnasium. It was tremendously successful and, as a result, the present building on Broadway was constructed. A complete junior high school program of study was added to the high school in 1989.

Today, Saratoga Central Catholic is the only high school serving Saratoga Springs and the surrounding communities. It currently offers a seven year

program of studies, an athletic program in which more than 80% of the student body participates, extracurricular activities that appeal to a wide variety of interests and a national recognized Campus Ministry program that focuses on reaching out to the community through service programs.

Students at Saratoga Central Catholic are entrusted to the care of its dedicated administration and faculty. They encourage them in their academic pursuits and serve as an example of firm, kind, understanding and just Christian educators.

In 1997, the school was recognized as one of the 25 most innovative schools in the country by Today's Catholic Teacher magazine. It is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Universities and produces young men and women well prepared to pursue high education. Some of the colleges and universities that our students attend are Clarkson, College of St. Rose, Marquette, Marist, and RPI.

In 2006, sixth grade was added to our program. The student body is entirely housed in the building on Broadway.



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
