Graduation Requirements

Students are required to complete the required course work and credits for a NY State Regents Diploma that include 4 Credits of English, 4 Credits of Social Studies, 3 Credits of Math, 3 Credits of Science, 1 Credit of Foreign Language, 1 Credit of Fine Arts, ½ Credit of Health, 2 Credits of Physical Education and 3.5 Credits of Electives.

In addition to the NY State Graduation Requirements all students attending Saratoga Central Catholic take 2 addition credits in a Foreign Language, ½ Credit of Theology each year, ½ Credit of Writer's Workshop each year, and an additional Math and Science course.
