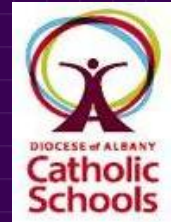

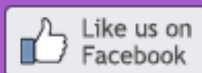


Mission Statement

Junior Time Line for College Selection and Fall Applications

May

- Work on updating resume in Naviance (Writer's Workshop)
- Take SAT or ACT Exam
- Attend Open Houses or make a college visit.
- Attend any school college visits that you may be interested in (listed in Naviance)

Remember that:

All transcript requests need to be made in Naviance to be sent out to the colleges. Requests should be at least 2 weeks in advance to ensure that the school materials are there by the deadline. Mrs. Barnes can not send out a transcript or information to a college if she does not know that you have applied.

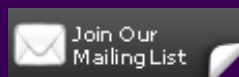
