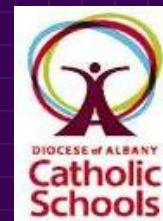

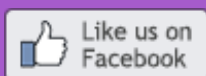


Mission Statement

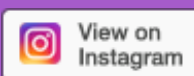



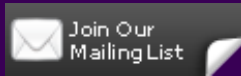
