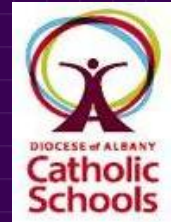

The Week of January 15th is usually the last deadline for all Regular College Applications. It is very important that Seniors have applied to their colleges by this date to ensure acceptance at the colleges they would like to attend.

All transcript requests need to be made in Naviance to be sent out to the Colleges. Request should be at least 2 weeks in advance to ensure that the school materials are there by the deadline. I can not send out a transcript or information to a college if I do not know that they have applied.

Any parent who would like to bring a snack or volunteer to work with the students, should contact Mrs. DuBois at dubois@saratogacatholic.org.

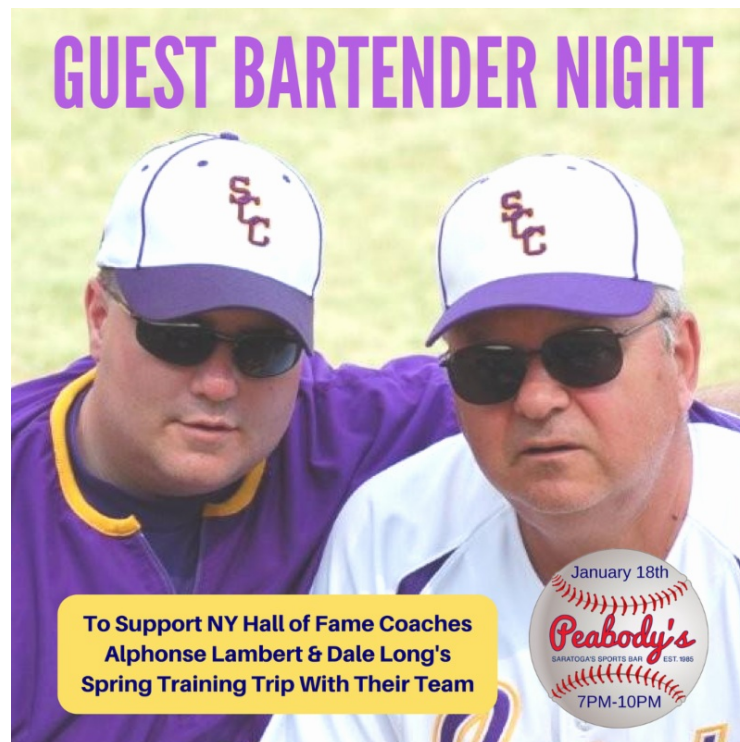
We will also practice on **Wednesday, January 18th from 2:30-4pm** (please note that our end time has changed for the month of January to 4 instead of 3:30).

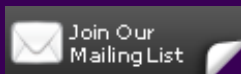
