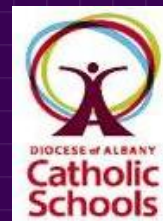

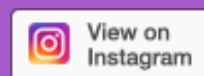
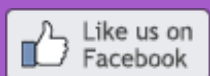

The story of a St. Peter's Academy graduate who led the capture of Japanese leader Hideki Tojo

On Thursday, April 19, 2018 the Saratoga Central Catholic community had the privilege of listening to a presentation from Associated Press reporter, Mr. Chris Carola. Mr. Carola presented the story of Lieutenant John "Jack" Wilpers and the capturing of General Hideki Tojo, Japan's Prime Minister, during WW II, making world headlines in the days following the end of the war against Japan.

The story of Lieutenant Wilpers began in Saratoga Springs, NY where he grew up, attended and graduated from St. Peter's Academy in 1937. In 1945, the 25 year old Saratogian was ordered to capture General Tojo, the notorious Japanese leader, alive. General Tojo attempted to commit suicide and Lt. Wilpers played an important role in keeping Tojo alive. As a result of Lieutenant Wilpers actions, Tojo was captured and eventually put on trial.

Sixty five years later while on vacation in Massachusetts Mr. Carola met John Wilpers, Jack's son while they were both wearing a Saratoga Race Course 2004 hat and an instant connection was made! As a result of this

meeting, Mr. Carola was finally able to convince Jack Wilpers to tell him his story from 1945. Thank you, Mr. Carola for sharing this remarkable story with the students at SCC.

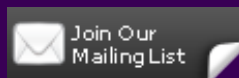
