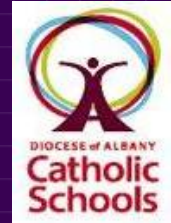

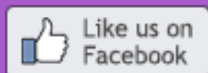

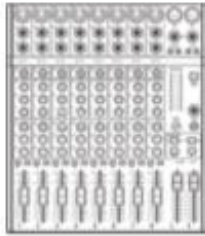

A Reminder from the nurse

Fall JV and Varsity school sports start August 13th. Modified (7th and 8th) can start September 1.

If your child signed up for a sport, there must be a **current physical exam** (within the last 12 months) on file in the nurse's office **prior** to the first practice. This physical must be completed by a **NYS** physician, physician's assistant or nurse practitioner.

A **Pre-participation/interval athletic form** must also be completed and signed by a parent if the student's PE is more than 30 days old from the beginning of the sport season. This form must be given to the nurse/coach **before** the first practice. Additional clearance may be needed for any recent injuries or health issues.

Any student who fails to provide the necessary documentation and completion of all health requirements will not be granted clearance to play. Please contact the nurse for any questions at 518-587-7070 ext. 210.

2018-2019 Revisions to School Health Regulations

Effective 7/1/18, the mandated years for health exams will change. Health examinations will be required in grades 7,9 and 11. (Previously required in grades 7 and 10). Physical exams will still be required for students new to the district and students participating in any school sport.

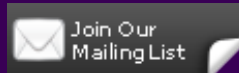
